ARCHITECTURAL STANDARD LOCKER DOOR REPLACEMENT

Revised March 21, 2017

In an effort to PROLONG THE LIFE OF THE LOCKER DOORS in the tough Florida environment, the Board has established the following standard. The materials to be used are all impervious to water and some of the salt air. **You are now required to get a permit from Collier County. 3/28/2017**

1. Removal of existing steel door system to include jamb and exterior molding off the property, to be disposed of **off the property**, not to be placed into our dumpsters.
2. Replace with “PlastPro” (www.plastproinc.com) or equal door meeting the fiberglass standard, that is a 6 panel smooth finish, composite (Fiberglass) door to match existing look. (Note: Locker doors at Compass Point vary in size.)
3. Jamb to be standard 4 3/8" size and to be PVC material with aluminum thresholds.
4. Exterior brick mold to be ¾" and match existing. Also to be PVC material.
5. Hardware to include stainless steel hinges and screws.
6. Door knob needs to be chrome finish
7. Keyed entry to be “Schlage” F51 Orbit.
